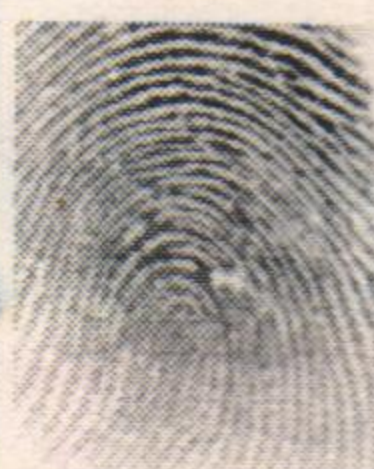

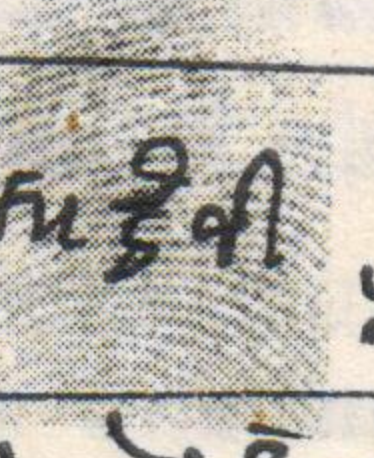

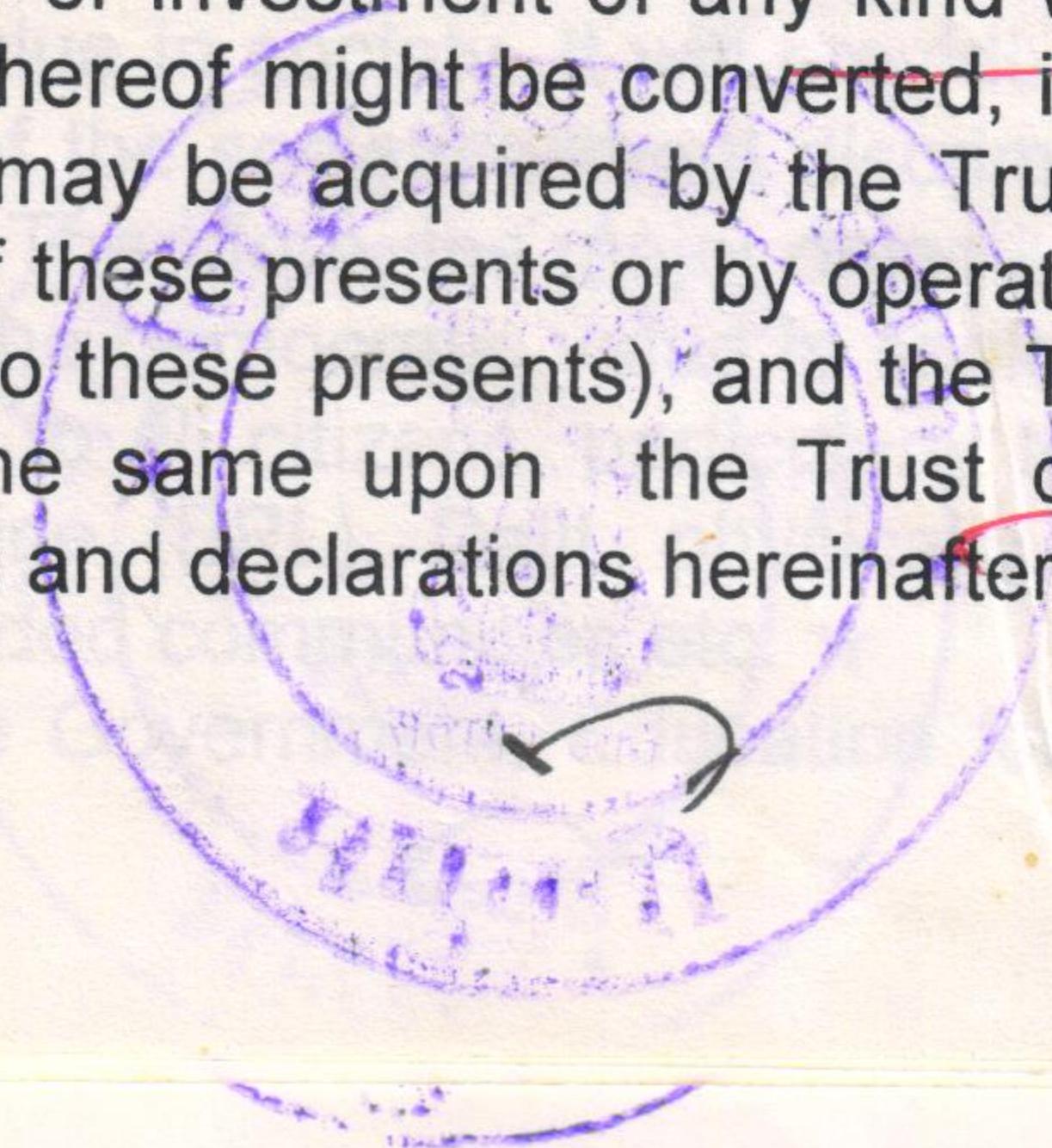

And whereas it is necessary to declare the objects and terms of the public charitable trust, being constituted under these presents.

Now this indenture witnesseth as follow:

That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the Trustees, a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty thousand only) (hereinafter called the 'Trust Fund' with expression shall include cash and any other property or investment of any kind whatsoever in to which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time or which may be acquired by the Trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents), and the Trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the Trust objects to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

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- 1 **Name** The name of the Trust shall be "**MUNDRIKA DEVI EDUCATIONAL TRUST**" (The Board of Trustees may change it if mutually so decided in future)
- 2 **Registered office** The registered office of the Trust shall be located at **Kataiya Road, Benipatti, P.S. Benipatti, Madhubani-847223 (Bihar)** and it can be changed at such other place as the Board of Trustees may decide from time to time.
- 3 **Area of Operation:** The operational area of the Trust shall be **whole India**.
- 4 **Administrative / Branches or Projects offices** Trust may have Administrative /Head Office, Branches or Projects offices in such places as decided by the Board of Trustees time to time within the operational area.
- 5 **Funds of the Trust** The assets, together with all further donations, contributions, membership fee, Indian and foreign grants, loan, profits and income thereof and the stocks, funds and properties representing the same shall be held by the Trustees upon Trust for the objects and purpose and subjects to powers and provisions hereinafter set out.

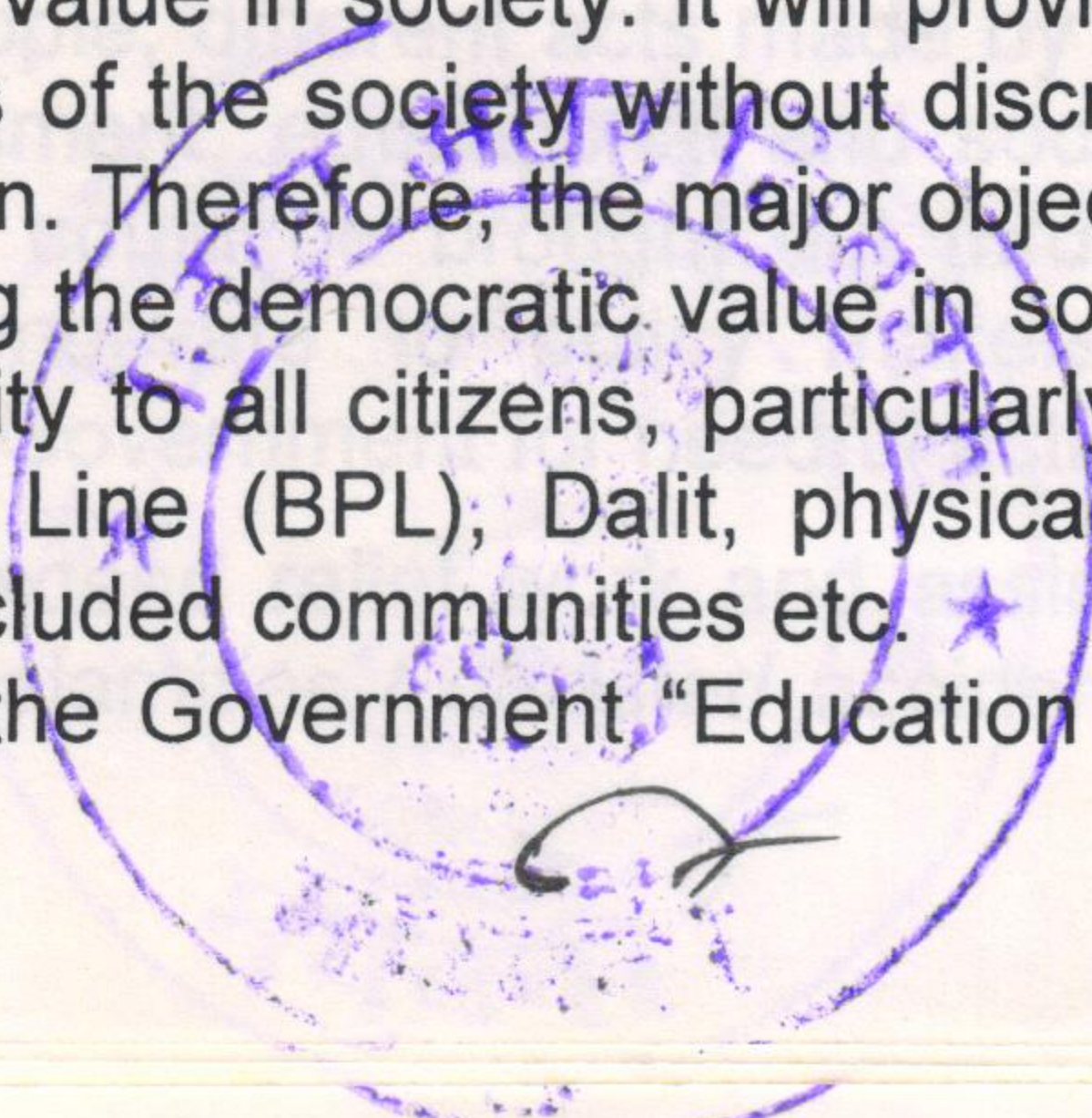
6 OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST

Trust will extend its services to 'All round Development of the Society' however it will focus on 'education for all' in general and backward and weaker/disadvantage /socially excluded community including Schedule Caste (SC) and Schedule Tribes (ST) in particular without discriminating caste, creed, race and religion. The integrated objectives of the Trust will be as under:

- 6.1 The trust will work under the components of the Constitution of India. Accordingly it will endeavor to **establish and strengthening** the democratic value in society. It will provide equal opportunity to all stakeholders of the society without discriminating caste, creed, race and religion. Therefore, the major objective of the Trust will be to strengthening the democratic value in society and try to provide equal opportunity to all citizens, particularly to women belongs to Below Poverty Line (BPL), Dalit, physically challenged persons and socially excluded communities etc.
- 6.2 The slogan of the Government "Education for all" is an important

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aspect of development of human resources. therefore, it will be one of the important objectives of the Trust will be to provide education, functional literacy to adult, job oriented education to all including women, children handicapped citizens of all other sections particularly disadvantaged groups. Value/ Character/ moral education will be preferred. In this area the Trust will opt innovation in education and conduct research / studies/ evaluation of on going educational structure, Seminar, workshop etc. as a supportive action of the Government. Urban Slum and Rural areas will be highly preferred. In this direction it will follow the rules and regulations of Central / state government which will be applicable on the Trust. In this light, the trust will also implement schools at different levels as per norms of the government.

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6.3 "Health for all" is another important aspect for the government as well as society. Therefore, the Trust will act towards providing support to government efforts and enabling people to get its benefits such as pre/post natal check-up, routine immunization, reproductive health, institutional delivery, HIV/AIDS, Reproductive Track Infection (RTI), Sexual Track Infection (STI) Reproductive Child Health (RCH) and common health and hygiene components. Besides, it will render health services to the society by establishing 'Health Service Centers' in urban or rural areas.

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6.4 Agriculture is the base of our nation. So the Trust will work for its betterment through scientific approaches. It will promote to make and use of organic manure and pesticide making through local available resources so that sustainable, eco -friendly and scientific practices could be ensured as to reduce global warming/ climatic change and enrich cultivation / production.

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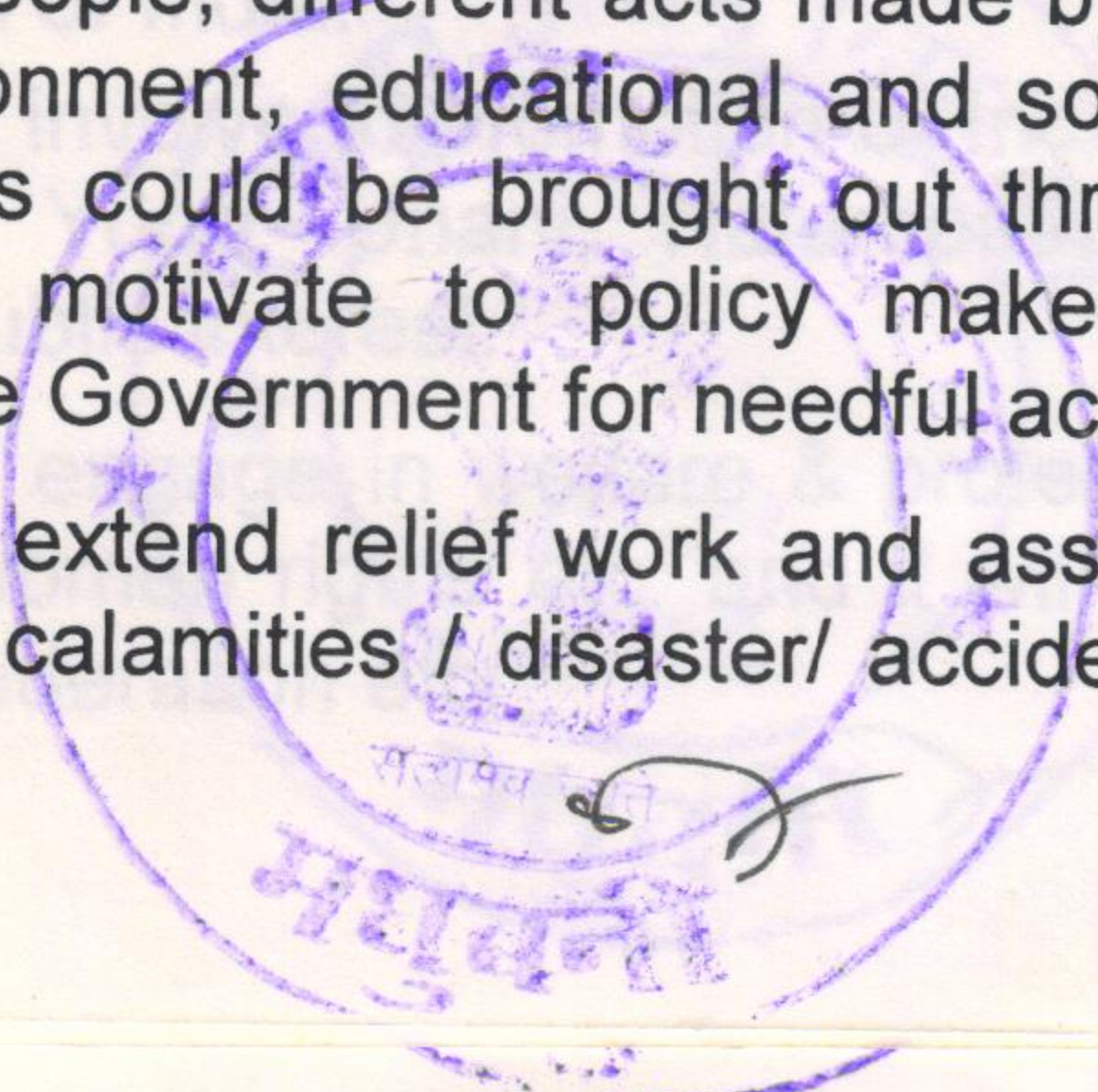
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6.5 Its aim to manage human wastage (excreta), animal wastage so that these wastages may be utilized in favors of society and protect the environment. Besides, it will extend its efforts towards encouragement to adopt indigenous agriculture system, plantation and other eco-friendly activities.

6.6 Languages, script art particularly folk arts and crafts are the major things to preserve. The society will work in this sphere. The society will find out the disappearable literatures, scripts, musical instruments and try to preserve these documents / instruments. Besides, it will establish old age home, short stay homes as per government norms.

6.7 The Trust will focus to make researches on different constitutional rights of the people, different acts made by Indian Parliament time to time, environment, educational and socio-economic issues so that new ideas could be brought out through researches which may lead to motivate to policy makers and implementation agencies of the Government for needful actions.

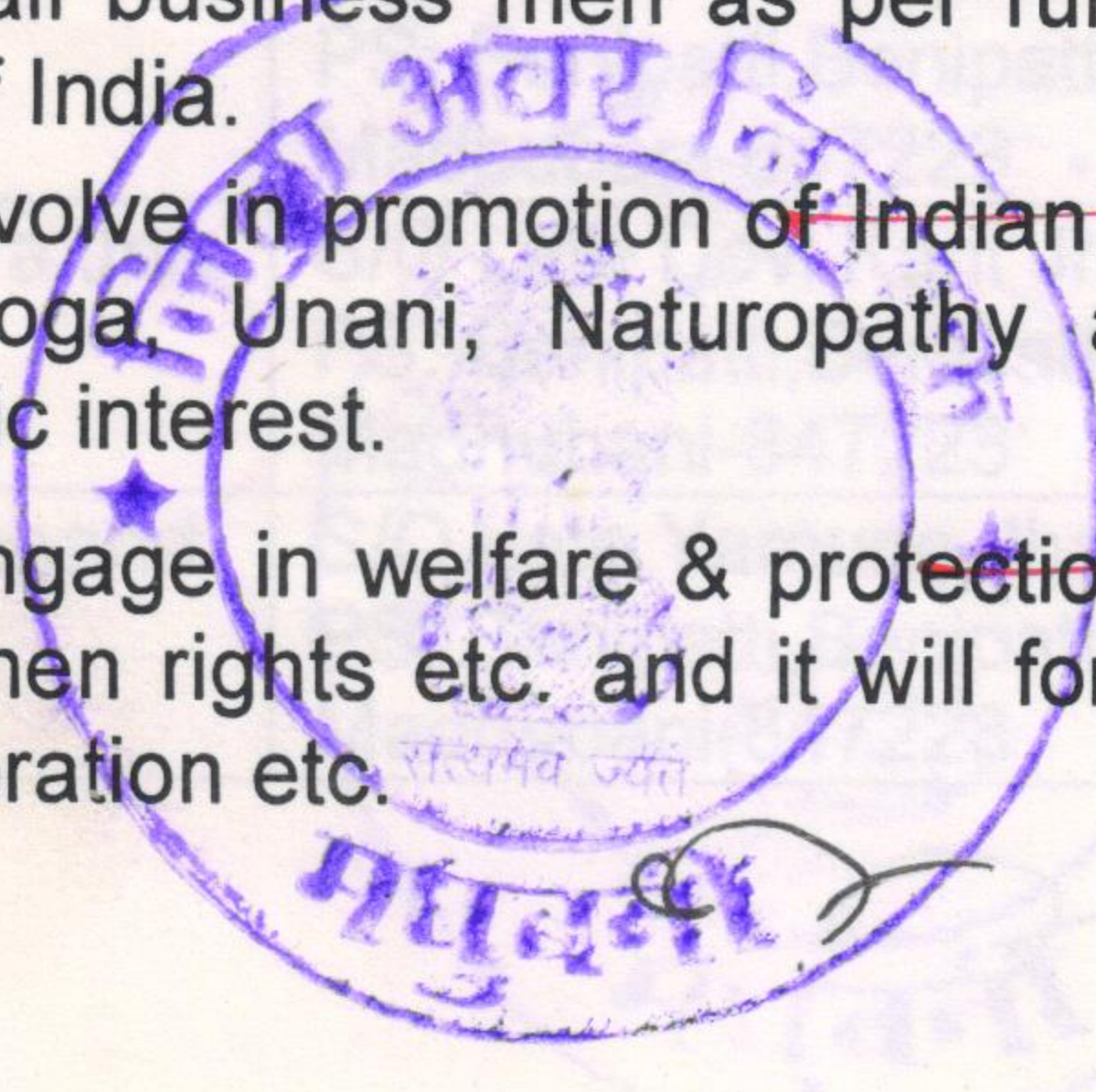
6.8 The Trust will extend relief work and assist to the needy victims during natural calamities / disaster/ accidents and others such as



- famine, earth quake, flood, fire, etc. and to give assistance to institutions or persons engaged in such relief work.
- 6.9** The Trust will establish coordination with Governmental agencies to implement developmental schemes in the interest of nation at large & to the poorest section.
- 6.10** The Trust will promote, conduct, undertaken or participate in national and international events, exhibitions, museums, seminars, conferences and conventions. The Trust will also organize such events such as seminar/ workshop/ symposium/ quiz etc among the students, civil societies at national and International level. Besides, it will promote friendship with neighboring countries of India by organizing events as listed above.
- 6.11** The Trust will engage in promotion of livelihood options to the poor and needy people particularly women and youth, the society will establish cottage industries in rural areas in corporation and support with different Ministries of Government of India and other governmental/ semi governmental agencies.
- 6.12** The Trust will educate people about the global Warming / Climate change and its impact of various aspects of people and its adaptation process
- 6.13** The Trust will conduct research/ studies, evaluation etc on various socio-economic and political aspects of the societies as well as government's acts, policies, recommendations etc.
- 6.14** To establish, run, develop and management of Hospitals, Medical / Pharmacy / Dental Collages, Nursing / Para Medical / Health Education Institutions, Dispensaries, Maternity Homes, Technical or Non Technical Institutions like Information Technology & Engineering Collages, Business Management Institutes, Child & Women Welfare Centers, Convent /Non-Convent School, Computer Training Institute, Library, Music / Drama / Acting / Dance Institutes, Science Park/ center and or other such similar institutions in India for the benefit of the general public. Besides, the Trust will also act to support to private and government organizations these institutions.
- 6.15** The Trust will act supportive actions for the better implementation of the Government's policies/ programmes in general and women, adolescents, handicapped and other stakeholders belong to disadvantage sections of the society in particular.
- 6.16** The Trust will involve in Micro credit & Micro finance among the women and small business men as per rule of Government and Reserve Bank of India.
- 6.17** The Trust will involve in promotion of Indian system of Medicine & Homeopathy, Yoga, Unani, Naturopathy and other system of medicine in public interest.
- 6.18** The Trust will engage in welfare & protection of consumer's right, child rights, women rights etc. and it will form and nurture of Co-operatives, Federation etc.

- 6.19 The Trust will promote, produce, sale and advertise audio-visual software/film for furtherance of aforesaid objects.
- 6.20 The Trust will promote and execute activities like sanitation, water supply, and rural health, construction in roads, and other for rural/urban reconstruction whenever necessary.
- 6.21 The Trust will establish network with different NGOs and other development institutions etc. It will also provide consultancy, placement and advisory services, undertake all acts, deeds and things connected with, incidental to and germane to the aforesaid objects.
- 6.22 Besides, the Trust will establish supportive actions of all the programmes of the Government of India as well as State Government.

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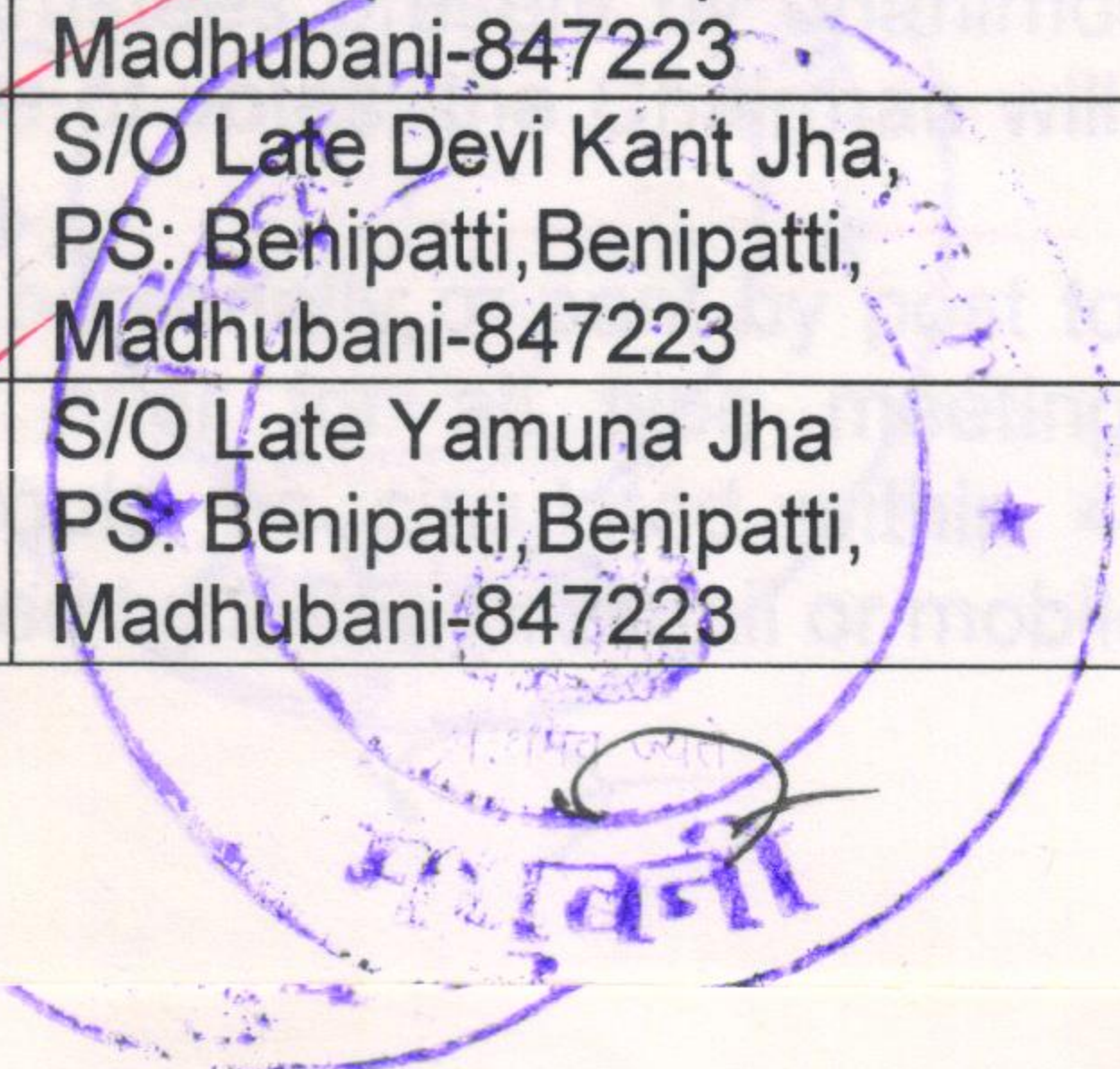
BY-LAWS OF THE TRUST

7. COMPOSITION OF BOARD OF TRUSTEES

7.1 The power of trust would be vested in 'Board of Trustee' (BoT). The Board of Trustee shall have minimum three and maximum nine members having one Chairman, Executive Director and Treasurer and maximum six trustees as member. Settler may participate in the meeting of 'Board of Trustees' but he will not entitle to cast his vote, however, in absence of Chairman, the Settler will act the power of Chairman. The Settler will be the permanent member of the trust. The tenure of other members including office bearers (Chairman, Executive Director and Treasurer) would be for three years. Settler would be the permanent member. In case of death and other causes the post of 'Settler' vacant the 'Board of Trustee' will select new 'Settler' among the family of previous 'Settler.'

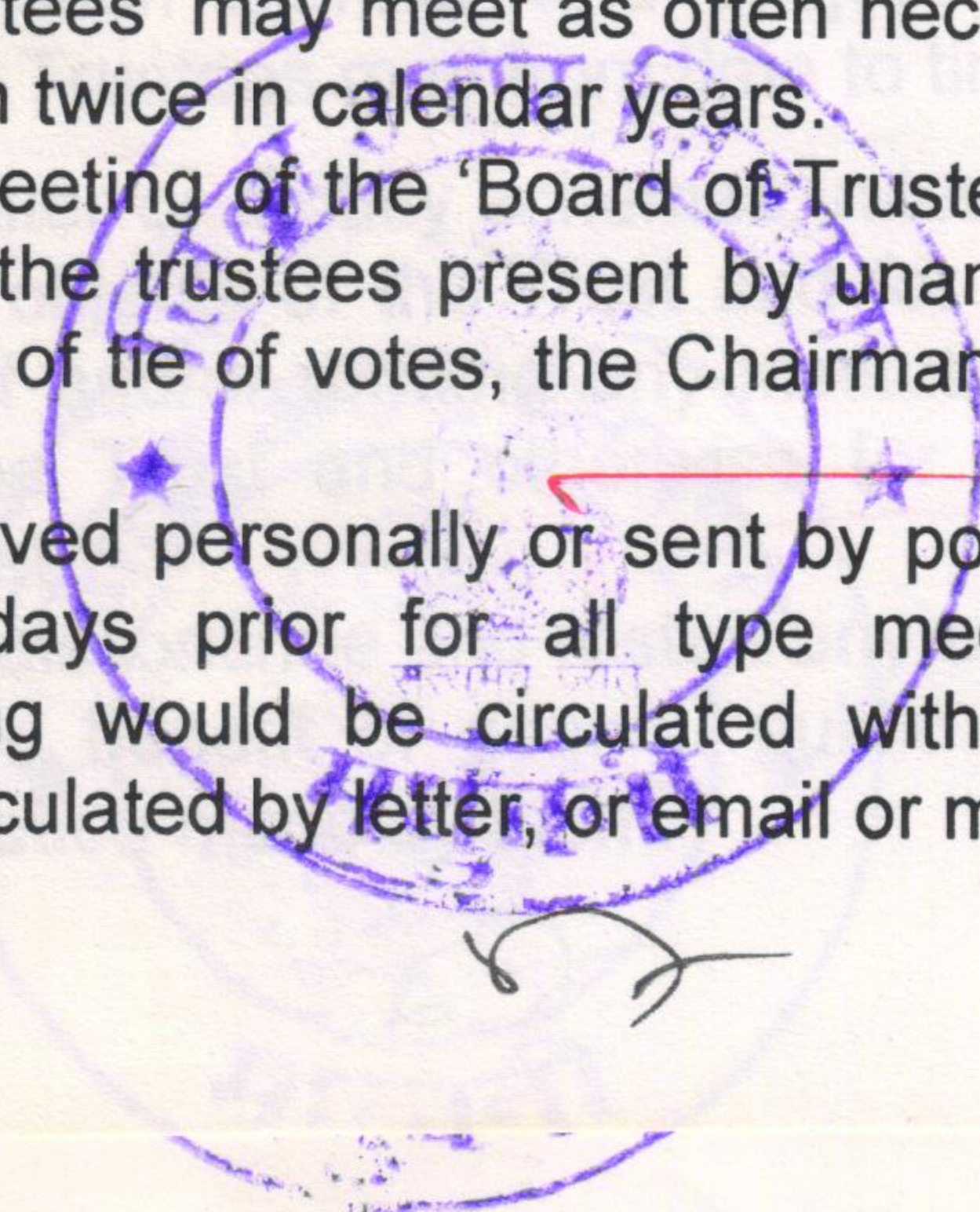

- 7.2** The first Trustees constituting the 'Board of Trustees' shall have the power to increase the strength of the 'Board of Trustees' but the total number of persons constituting the 'Board of Trustees' shall at no time exceed nine.
- 7.3** In the event of vacancy in the office of chairman, the board shall elect a Chairman from amongst themselves or persons of out side as Board of Trustee decides.
- 7.4** If any of the time Trustee(s) shall die, or desire to retire, refuse or become incapacitated to act as a Trustee or take the benefit of Insolvency Law, then and in every such case, there shall be vacancy in the 'Board of Trustees' the 'Board of Trustees' may appoint new trustee(s).
- 7.5** Any trustee may be removed from his post of 'trustee' by 'Board of Trustees' on following grounds-(i) if the trustee becomes unfit or personally incapable to act in the trust;(ii) if found guilty of (a)misconduct or abuse of office, (b) acting dishonestly or fraudulently, (c) misappropriation of trust funds, (d) moral turpitude, (e) application of trust property to private purpose etc. or decision of 2/3 majority of the same.
Besides, the trustee may be removed by a resolution adopted by two-third majority of the members of the 'Board of Trustees' present and voting at a meeting specially called for the purpose. The Trustees affected shall be given reasonable opportunity to cause against the proposed action. However, the decision of 'Board of Trustees' will be the final.
- 7.6** Vacancies in the 'Board of Trustees' may be filled by the remaining Trustees or outsiders in the meeting called for the purpose. Any trustee may re-elect.
- 7.7** The quorum for a meeting of the 'Board of Trustees' shall be 1/3rd of the existing members. If the meeting has not a quorum within one hour of the fixed time, the meeting shall be adjourned to the same day and time at the same place for the next week. Adjourned meeting shall not require having a quorum.
- 7.8** The 'Board of Trustees' may meet as often necessary and, in any event, not less than twice in calendar years.
- 7.9** Decisions at the meeting of the 'Board of Trustees' shall be taken by 2/3 majority of the trustees present by unanimous decision or voting. In the case of tie of votes, the Chairman will cast final and decisive votes.
- 7.10** Notice shall be served personally or sent by post to the 'Board of Trustees' seven days prior for all type meetings. Notice for emergency meeting would be circulated within 48 hours. The notice would be circulated by letter, or email or mobile phone.

8 POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF 'BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

For the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, the 'Board of Trustees' shall have the following powers and functions:

- 8.1** To accept any donation, contribution, grant, loan or subscription in cash or kind, from any person(s), body of persons or trust, Govt./Semi-Govt. department or agency, national or international donor, with or without conditions.
- 8.2** To apply the whole or any part of the income of the Trust, or the Trust-Fund or accumulations, thereto, to anyone or more of the trust, as the in Trustees may, their discretion, deem fit from time to time
- 8.3** To convert and deal with the Trust property and/ or any investments for the time being.
- 8.4** To invest the Trust-Funds either in the purpose the mortgage of immovable property or in shares, stock or in debenture or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank, firm or any other person, and to alter, vary or transpose such investments, from time to time at the discretion of the 'Board of Trustees'
- 8.5** To borrow or raise or secure payments of money and also to lend money either with or without security.
- 8.6** To sale, dispose of alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust-Funds
- 8.7** To let-out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust-Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- 8.8** To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration all action, suits, claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust-Funds.
- 8.9** To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rule and regulations as the Trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate Trustees or hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.
- 8.10** To, make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- 8.11** To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity of charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions or donation made by them.

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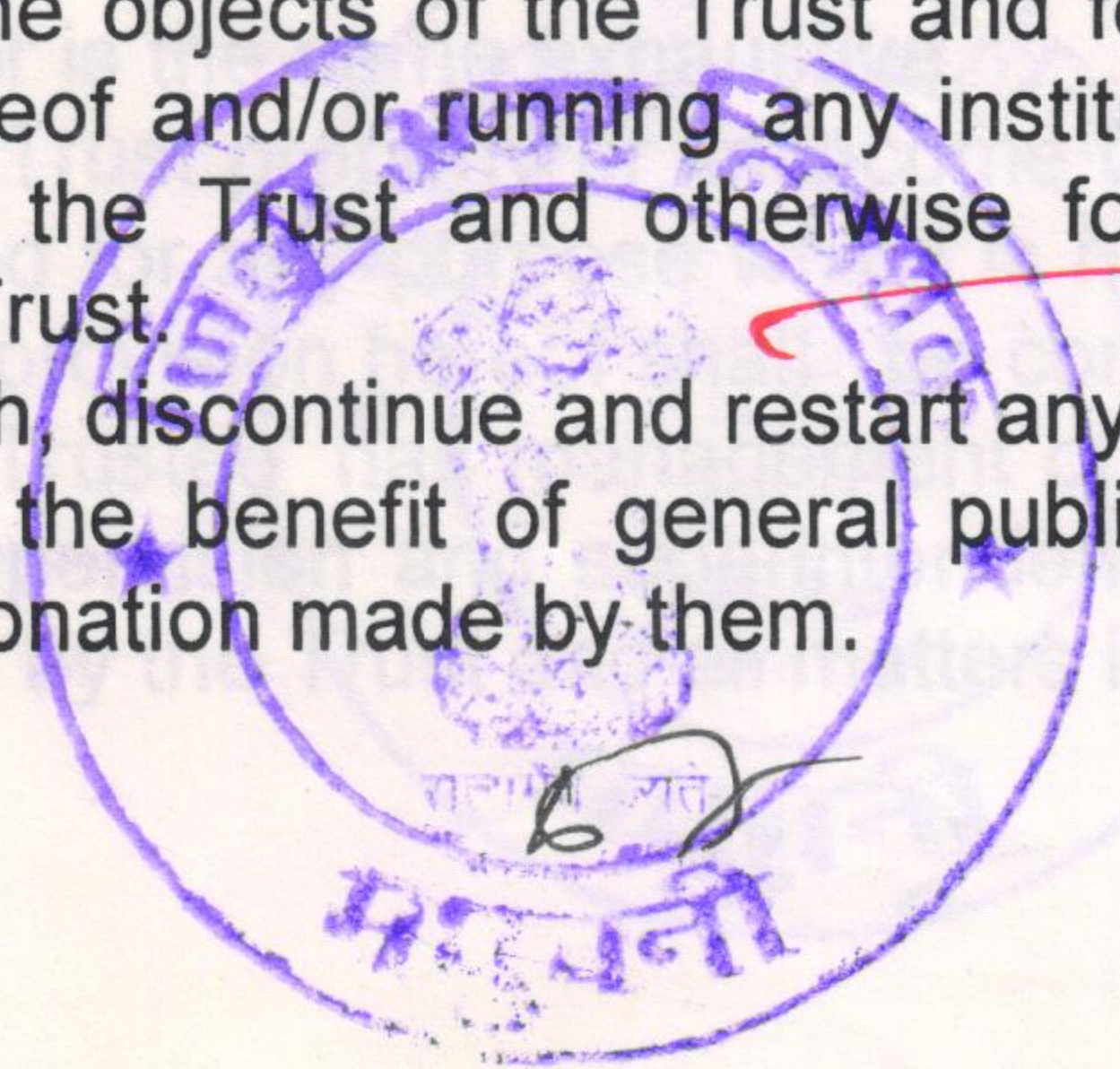

8.20 No part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose which is but a charitable purpose in law; and all provisions here of shall be controlled accordingly.

8.21 Any trustee including office bearers and settler may hold any post of trust or its project and can get admissible facilities.

9 **POWER AND FUNCTION OF 'BOARD OF TRUSTEES'**

Power and Function of the CHAIRMAN

9.1 He will Preside all meetings of the 'Board of Trustees.'

9.2 He will take final decision by casting; his vote in case of 'tie' vote

9.3 He will sign on the notice of meetings of 'Board of Trustee' and on proceedings.

9.4 **Power and Function of the SETTLER**

9.5 The Settler will be treated as 'Respectable Person' of the trust. He will take part in 'Board of Trustees' but he will not entitle for voting. However, in absence of the Chairman, the Settler will act as Chairman of the trust and explore all powers and functions of the Chairman.

9.6 **Power and Function of the EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR (ED)**

9.7 The Executive Director will be the Chief Functionary of the trust and overall responsible for proper functioning of Trust. He will hold control of the functioning of the trust and take any decision related to better functioning of trust or its other activities.

9.9 To take appropriate action as may be necessary to implement the decisions of the 'Board of Trustees'.

9.10 Day-to-day management of the business of the Trust. Convening meeting of the 'Sub Committees' of the trust or project work.

9.11 Advice the 'Board of Trustees' in the policy formulation, programmers etc.

9.12 Furnishing to the 'Board of Trustees' periodical necessary for apprising it of the operations of the Trust.

9.13 Sign or authorized to any person to sign on the documents for and on behalf of the Trust

9.14 Making appointment to the staff of trust or any other project and dismiss them if he found any reasonable cause.

9.15 Assign job responsibilities to other Trustees or other project staff as may be appropriate for management of the affairs of the Trust. Making arrangements for the proper maintenance of various account books and records of the Trust. He will also responsible for audit by Charter Accountant every year.

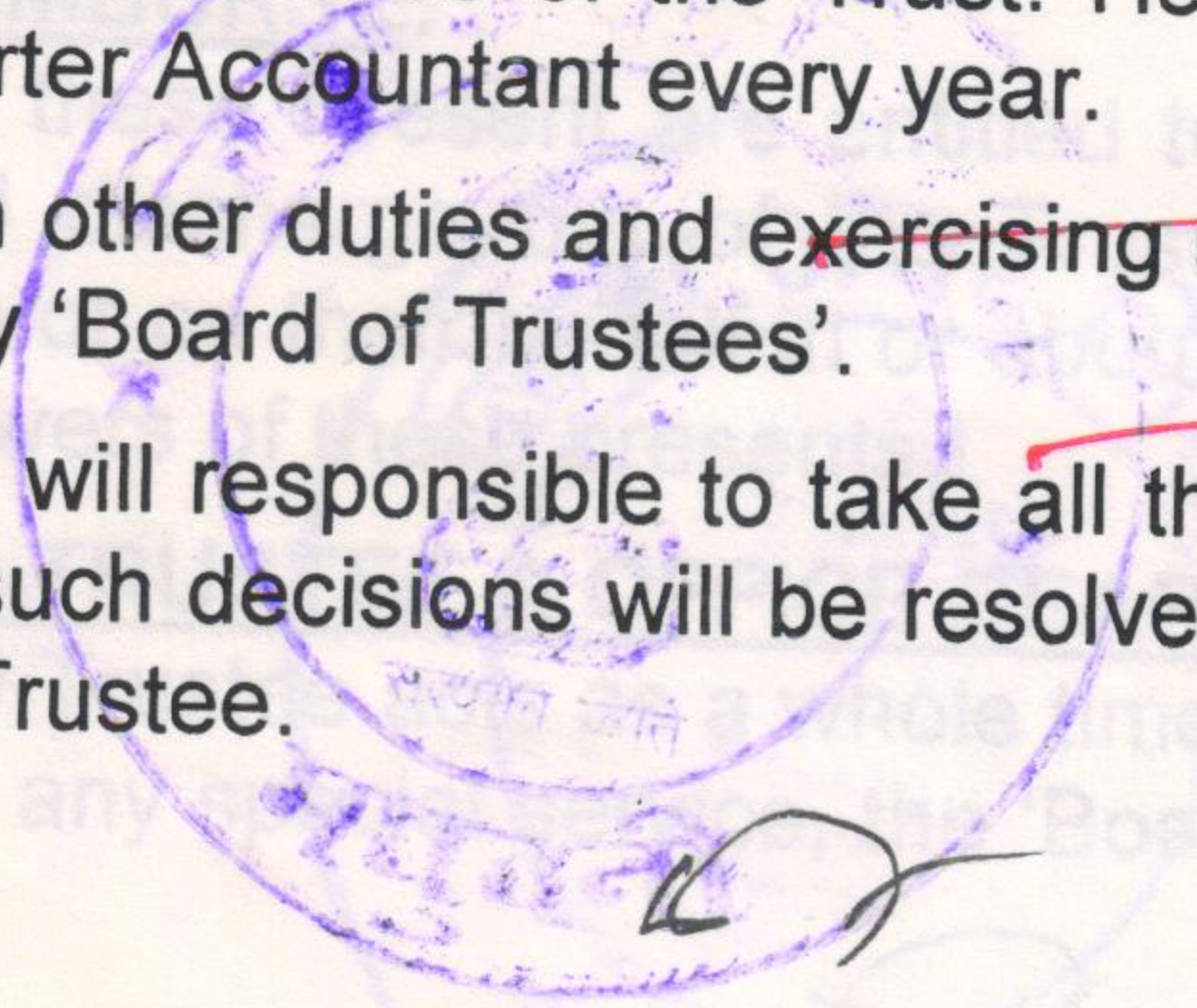
9.16 Performing such other duties and exercising such other powers as may assigned by 'Board of Trustees'.

9.17 Besides, he/she will responsible to take all the decisions in favour of Trust but all such decisions will be resolved in the next meeting of the Board of Trustee.

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10 ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT

10.1 Accounts of Trust:

The account of the Trust shall be opened any where of its operational areas by name of Trust "**MUNDRIKA DEVI EDUCATIONAL TRUST**". Its account will be opened in any Nationalized Bank or other bank approved or permitted by Reserve Bank of India or in post office.

10.2 Operation of Account:

The joint signature of any two Trustees such as Chairman, Executive Director, and Treasurer would operate the accounts. But the signature of the Executive Director would be essential for its operation. In case of accounts being opened at different towns/ rural/ semi-rural areas, the 'Board of Trustee' will decide of its mode of operation.

10.3 FINANCIAL YEAR

1st April to 31st March will be the financial year of the Trust

10.4 AUDIT OF ACCOUNTS

The audit of the accounts will be conducted by the Charter Accountant from any where of the nation.

11 AMMENDMENTS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS:

The amendment in the any part of the Rules and Regulations will be made through 3/5 votes of the 'Board of Trustee'.

12 LEGAL ACTION

Any legal action will be taken against Executive Director and Executive Director will be entitled to take legal action against any person in favour of the trust.

13 POWER OF AMALGAMATE:

The accounts of the Trust shall be audited every year by a Chartered Accountant or a firm of chartered Accountants that will be appointment by The 'Board of Trustees' with the consultation of the Executive Director.

14 INDEMNITY

The Trustees shall be chargeable only for such money, stocks, funds, deposit and securities as they shall actually receive not withstanding their singing any receipt for the sake of conformity, and shall be answerable or accountable only for their own deliberate or willful acts of omission or commission.

No Trustees shall be liable for any breach of trust committed by the co-trustee except in respect of his own act and in respect of any property in his custody

15 POWER OF REIMBURSE:

The Trustees of these Present are entitled to be reimbursed and also to pay and discharge out of the Trust-Fund, all expenses incurred by them or on their behalf in or about the execution of the Trust and the powers of these presents.

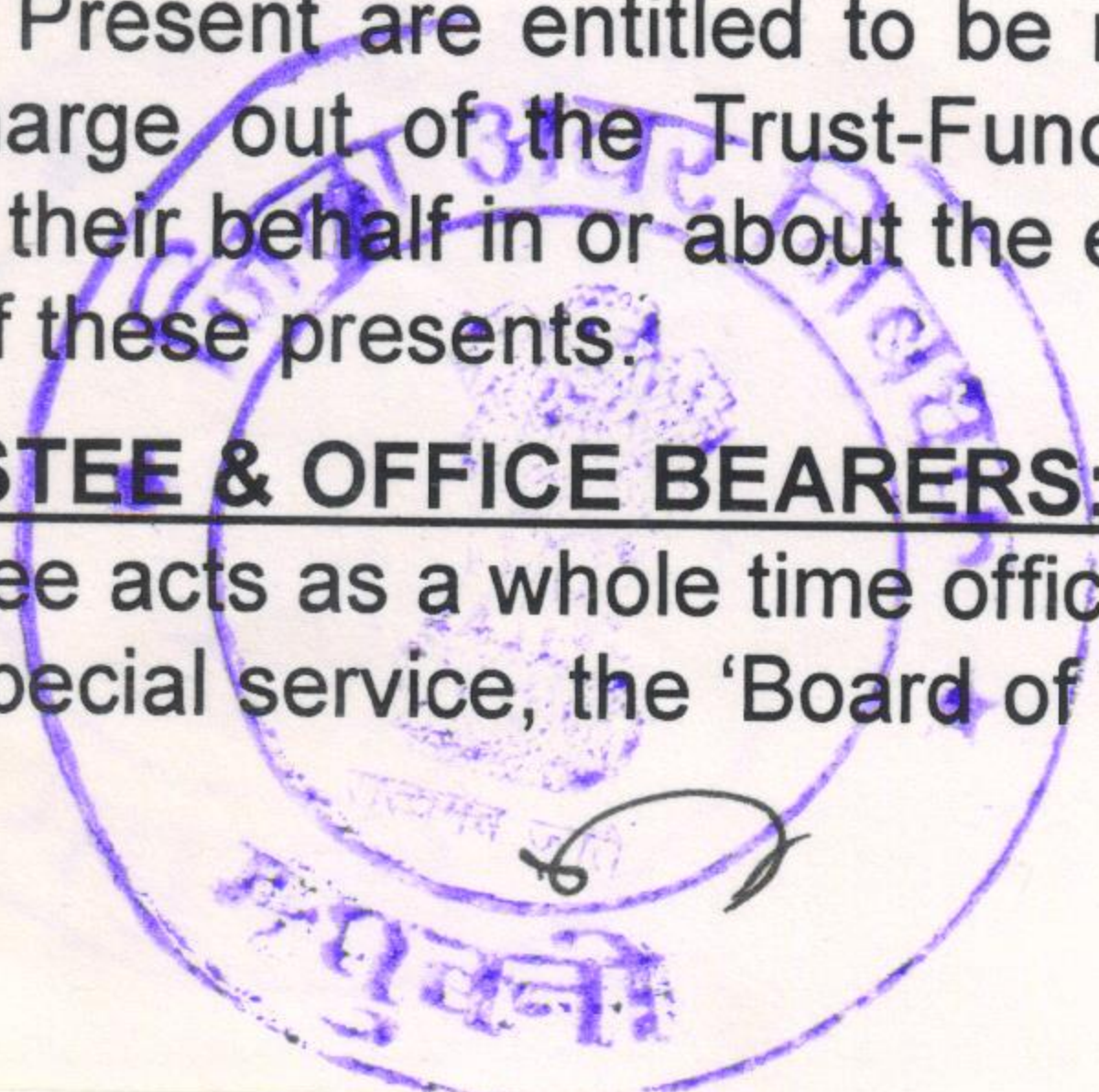
16 ALLOWANCE TO TRUSTEE & OFFICE BEARERS:

If at any time any Trustee acts as a whole time office- bearer of the Trust or renders any special service, the 'Board of Trustee' may in

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its discretion pay such remuneration or allowances to such Trustee as it may think proper.

17 DISSOLUTION

In case it becomes necessary to wind up or otherwise determine this Trust for whatsoever reason, neither the Settler Trustees nor his heirs nor the Trustees for the time being nor any other person shall have any manner of right over such funds of Trust or any other property. The net funds and other assets if any after meeting all liabilities will be handed over to any other similar Trust or Institution satisfying requirements of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and/or other laws applicable as may be decided by the Trustees subject further to the condition that it shall be so given to an Institution or Trust as approved by the Commissioner of Income Tax or Director of Tax Exemptions or any other such authority as the case may be.

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18 Jurisdiction of Courts:

The jurisdiction of court of the trust will be Madhubani or Patna High Court, Patna. It will depend on the nature of matter.

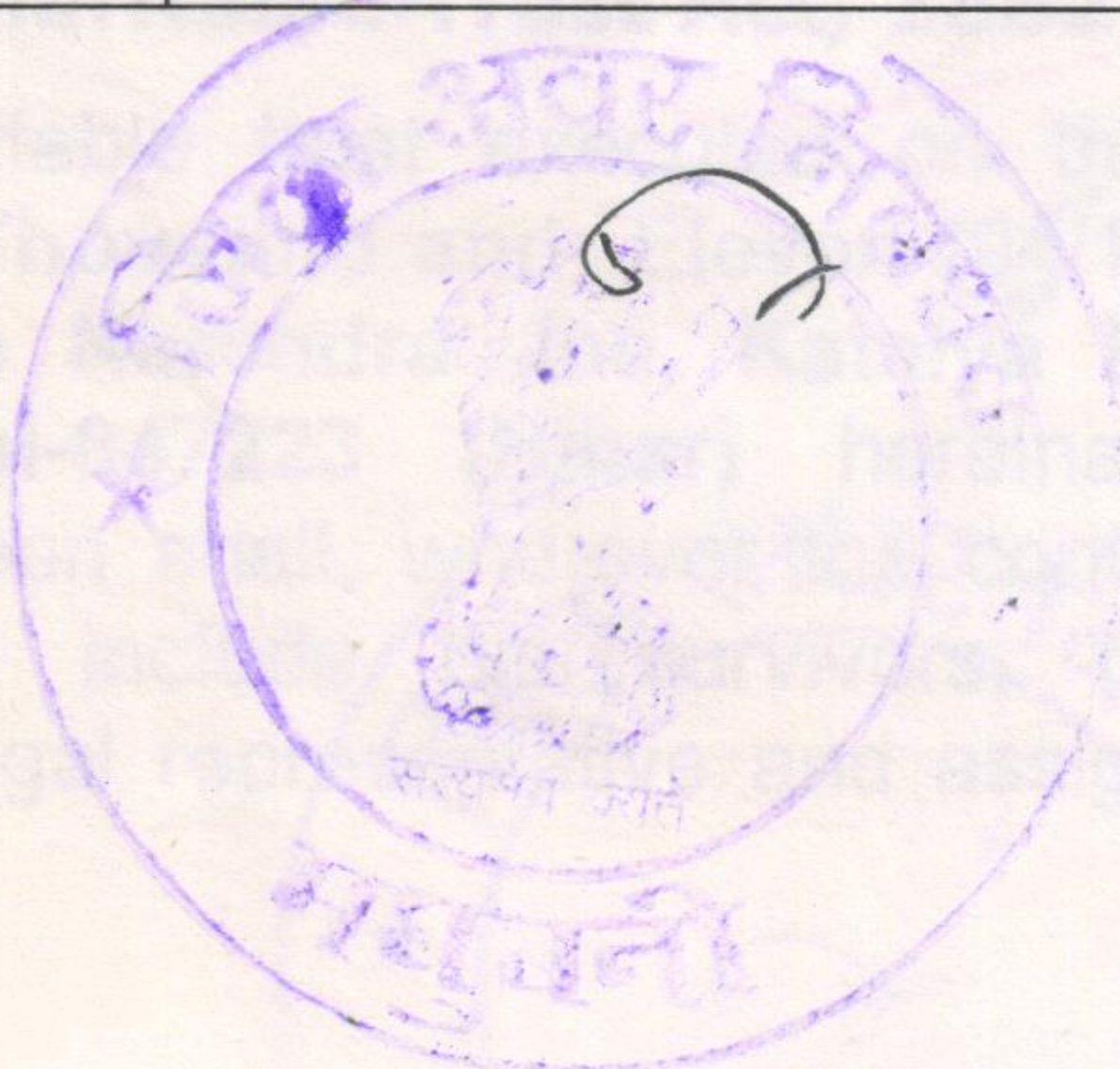
